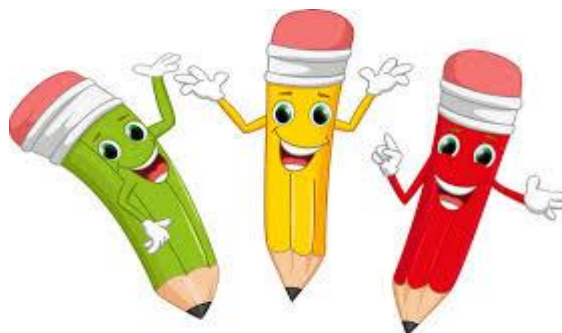


Easter Raffle
