## Scooters

Although we welcome children riding scooters to school, we would ask that they do not ride them onto the school site for health and safety reasons please.

E-scooters are a relatively new mode of transport and as such the Government is trialling various schemes and developing the guidance around their safe use. However, (at the time of writing this newsletter) many are still unaware that escooters are classed as 'Personal Light Electric Vehicles' (PLEVs), which means they are treated as motor vehicles and subject to the same legal requirements such as:

- Driving licence
- Insurance
- Number plates
- Lighting
- Brakes
- Type approval
- Road tax
- Crash helmets etc.

E-scooters cannot be used legally on the road without these and in no circumstances is it legal to use them on the pavement. **Top Attenders**
