
Dear Parents


Mad for Maths

Extended School Hours

In our newsletter last week we highlighted the government requirement for all state funded maintained schools to provide a compulsory school week of at least 32.5 hours by September 2023. This means that from September our school day must be extended. From September the school gate will open at 8.30a.m. with registration at 8.40a.m. The school day will end at 3.10p.m. for all year groups. These timings have been decided so that they fit in with those of Balfour Junior Academy, allowing parents with children at both schools to drop off and collect their children and also to allow families to make use of the before and after school provision run by MFSE at the junior school.
