Year R – Thursday 23rd March 2023

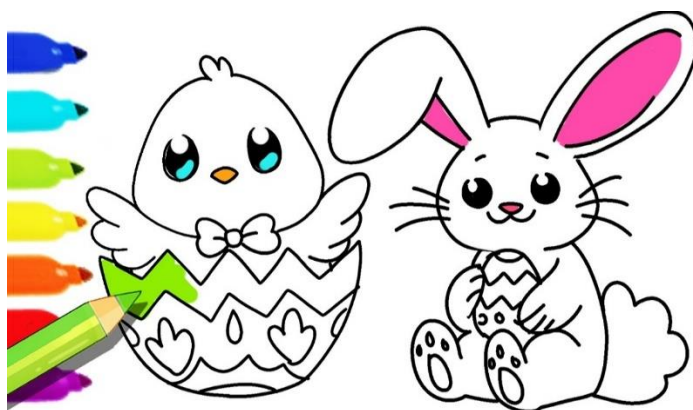
Year 1 – Friday 24th March 2023
